### Day 1 - Wednesday, May 8, 2024: Head to Israel

The moment we walk into the airport we begin to feel the excitement increase as we suddenly realize we're going to walk the land of the Bible, the land where Jesus walked and still walks today.

### Day 2 - Thursday, May 9, 2024: Arrive in Israel

We land at Ben Gurion International airport, Bruchim Ha Baim, we are greeted by a "JET" representative, we board our air-conditioned bus and we are transferred to our hotel on the Mediterranean coast.

### Day 3 - Friday, May 10, 2024: Heading to the Galilee

We begin today travelling to Jaffa, Jonah's Port, and visit the house of Simon the Tanner. Driving north, we explore the ancient ruins of Caesarea, here, we will visit the Roman amphitheater where Paul stood trial. It was here that the Holy Spirit first fell on the gentiles as Cornelius, the first Gentile of the Churchage, met Peter. We continue driving up the Mediterranean Coast to Mount Carmel, the place where the Prophet Elijah defeated the false prophets of Ba'al. We proceed to drive through the Valley of Jezreel, the prophetic future site of Armageddon. Finally, the day ends with a magnificent view of the Sea of Galilee, here, we will spend the next two nights.

### Day 4 - Saturday, May 11, 2024: Galilee & Golan

We begin the morning with a scrumptious buffet breakfast at our hotel. we then enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. A short drive takes us to the Mt. of Beatitudes, we walk downhill towards the site of where Jesus fed the multitudes. We make our way now to Capernaum and visit the home of Peter where Jesus healed Peter's mother-in-law. A few steps away we visit the site of the synagogue where Jesus taught and continue to Tabgha, the site of the miracle of the multiplication of loaves and fish. Following a St. Peter's Fish lunch (at own expense), we continue to Caesarea Philippi where Jesus asked His disciples, "Who do men say that I am?". And Peter said, "Thou are the Messiah, the Son of the Living God". And Jesus replied, "upon this rock I shall build my assembly and the gates of hell will not prevail against it" (Matthew 16:16-18). We proceed to Mt. Bental and ascend onto the Golan Plateau for a magnificent view of upper Israel. Overnight: Tiberias, Leonardo Hotel

### Day 5 - Sunday, May 12, 2024: Up to Zion

Today starts with a visit to Mt. Arbel, from here we proceed to Gideon's Spring, where God chose an army of 300 men. We have an opportunity to be baptized in the Jordan River. Traveling southward to Beit-She'an, which is one of the most incredible archaeological sites in Israel. This is the city where the Philistines hung the bodies of Saul and his sons who were killed on Mt Gilboa (I Samuel 31:10-12). When Jesus walked here it was named Scythopolis, one of the chief cities of the Decapolis. As we travel south, we will follow the Jordan Valley as we see for ourselves the incredible agricultural restoration of the land of milk and honey. At Mt. Scopus we marvel at the view of the City of Gold.

# Day 6 - Monday, May 13, 2024: Jerusalem, City of Our Great King!

The day starts with a panoramic view of the Temple Mount, Mount Moriah, Dome of the Rock as we stand on top of the Mount of Olives, then a short walk down the mountain to the Garden of Gethsemane (Church of All Nations). This is probably one of the more memorable and emotional times as we remember that night when Jesus prayed, 'let this cup pass from me', and began the suffering which led to our redemption. Walking among these ancient olive trees, reading the scriptures, we take time for personal devotion and reflection in the presence of our great God. We enter the Old City and explore the Christian Quarter. After visiting St. Anne's Church and the Pool of Bethesda, we continue to Bethlehem, we visit the Church of Nativity and Shepherd's Field. Overnight: Jerusalem, Ramat Rachel Resort

### Day 7 - Tuesday, May 14, 2024: Jerusalem, Where Peace Has Been Established

We begin this morning visiting the Temple Mount. Next, we go to Ir David (City of David), at the Gihon Spring, we learn of how David overtook the city from the Jebusites, one of the cities Joshua did not conquer. After walking through Hezekiah's Tunnels, we visit the Pool of Siloam. We continue the day with a life changing visit to Yad Vashem where we will remember those whose lives were lost during the Holocaust. The Holocaust Memorial is a place both of great sadness and an experience of the spirit of hope and triumph, for those who trust in the Messiah. Following a visit to a local Jewish market we end the day praying over Jerusalem at a prayer tower.

### Day 8 - Wednesday, May 15, 2024: Dead Sea

After breakfast, we head to the Dead Sea and visit Ein Gedi where David fled from Saul. Continuing south through the wilderness of Judea, we will ascend by cable car to Masada, here, is the worlds oldest operating Jewish synagogue. We visit the remains of Herod's Palace, the apartments, baths, storehouses and cisterns. It was here the Jewish Zealots made their last stand against the Roman Legions from 70-73 AD. We descend from Masada with a stunning view of the Dead Sea. Our next stop will be at the Qumran caves, where the Dead Sea scrolls were found. If time permits, we enjoy an optional float and swim in the Dead Sea.

### Day 9 - Thursday, May 16, 2024: Shalom!

We begin this day standing on Mt. Zion. We visit the room of the Last Supper (Mark 14:13, Luke 22:10-38. Matt. 26:17-29. Acts 1:13. and Acts 2 The Pentecost), also known as the site of the Upper Room, and the traditional site of the Tomb of King David. We visit the Southern Wall of the Temple Mount excavations which was for the common people, the Priests and Levites entered on the higher eastern side of the mount. Parts of the stairs leading to the Temple Mount as well as some of the purification pools can be viewed. This is the general area where Jesus would have driven out the money changers. The south eastern pinnacle is said to be where Jesus was tempted to throw Himself down when tempted by the Enemy. We finish this day with a visit at Gordons Calvary, Golgotha, and the Garden Tomb, we have Holy Communion and celebrate together the eternal hope we have in Yeshua, for He is Risen.

Overnight: Jerusalem, Ramat Rachel Resort

### Day 10 - Friday, May 17, 2024: Shalom!

This morning we are transferred to Ben Gurion Airport to travel home.
